For those who may be new to Extension, the state 4-H photography contest is a senior-only qualifying contest where photos qualify directly from COUNTY to STATE. Each county may submit no more than 1 photo per category (15 total). As stated in the rules, counties are highly encouraged to have some type of selection process in place to determine which photos are eligible. The timeline for entry is April 1-15. If you have questions about this contest, please contact Derrick Bruton. Key points:

- ⇒ Qualify from county level (district contests have no bearing on qualifications)
- ⇒ Open to senior age division only
- ⇒ 15 categories (includes a new “Abandoned” theme for this year)
