Texas State 4-H Dog Show

Texas State 4-H Horse Show

Over 350 youth participated in Texas' 2024 State 4 H Horse Show in Bryan/College Station over a week of competition from July 20th through the 27th where youth from all over Texas participated in 50 different competitive events.

Carly Rae Colvin of Uvalde, who will be a Senior at Uvalde Classical Academy this fall, participated in 14 events at the Texas State 4-H Horse Show.

The competition was deep this year with 10 of the 14 events that Carly Rae participated in requiring a preliminary round and finals round due to the large number of participants. Those large classes included Barrels, Pole Bending, Stake Race, English Showmanship, Stock Horse Showmanship, Stock Horse Horsemanship, Stock Horse Pleasure and Reining.

Competing on her gelding "Cruz Mode" Carly brought home a custom buckle as Reserve Champion in Reining. She also placed 6th in Working Cow Horse, was top 15 in Stockhorse Horsemanship and Stockhorse Pleasure. Riding her horse "Chic" she brought home another custom buckle for second place in Goat Tying.

On her horse "Issy Joe Cash", Carly and Izzy took 8th place in Western Pleasure, 9th in Western Showmanship and 4th in English showmanship. On her speed horse "Delight", she placed 10th in Barrels and 10th in Pole Bending bettering 51 other competitors in Barrels and 44 others in Poles.

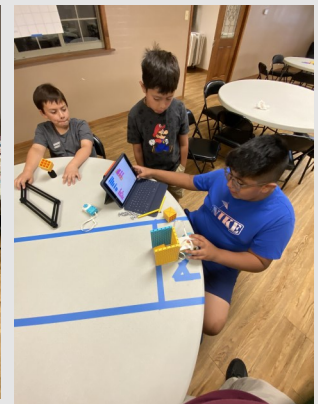
